Complex aromas of roses, berries, cedar and citrus follow through to a full-bodied palate, with fine tannins and a silky, refined finish. A beauty. This is a new wine and marks the beginning of a new strategy for Parusso, blending his former Rocche, Mugnie and Fiurin *crus* together. Best after 2007. 1,080 cases made.—J.S.
