Parusso's 2006 Barolo Le Coste-Mosconi is simply superb. The late harvest in 2006 yielded a wine blessed with gorgeous, articulate aromatics, beautifully ripe fruit and finessed tannins, all of which add tons of class to what is essentially a full-throttle, fruit-driven Barolo. A vein of minerality runs through the wine from start to finish, adding a degree of freshness that is unusual for such a big Barolo. The textural richness and balance here are drop-dead gorgeous. Anticipated maturity: 2016-2031.

The 2006 Barolo Mariondino is built on a core of floral red fruit. Despite its medium-bodied personality, the Mariondino packs a surprising punch. This utterly engaging Barolo possesses superb depth and lovely persistence on the palate. It is a wonderful effort from this site. Anticipated maturity: 2016-2026.

The 2006 Barolo flows from the glass with red fruit, herbs, spices and flowers in an attractive, mid-weight style. The tannins are delicate as they frame a soft, lovely finish.
